With regard to a warning for measured pH in 1,5 mineral water which does not correspond to the value indicated on the label we are making the following clarification:

In accordance with art. 22, paragraph 3 of the Ordinance on the requirements for bottled natural mineral, spring and table waters intended for drinking purposes, in force in Republic of Bulgaria, where the product is manufactured, the label should contain „data for the physicochemical and chemical analysis of water, determining its characteristic composition as per the certificate“.

Concerning these data the country in the person of the Ministry of Health issues a special certificate which we enclose here, namely: Certificate No10/23.09.2014, issued by the Ministry of Health, from which it is obvious that the pH is 9,42. The Active Reaction index is determined by using pH measurement unit based on the standard BDS 3424.

We draw your attention to the fact that the analysis of Active Reaction index /pH/ must be based on standardized methods of analysis, which are statutorily recognized in the country manufacturer, not on random ones.

Devin AD observes all the valid for Republic of Bulgaria and the countries of the European Union legal requirements for manufacturing and labeling our products.
